







This period conversion underwent a full, back-to-brick makeover. Tired, aged interiors with fantastic potential were lifted and given a refreshed lease of life.


We coordinated the design schemes from room to room to ensure synchronicity and cohesiveness between spaces. High-end, high-spec interiors still feel lived in and personable, with bespoke shelves displaying sentimental items lovingly collected by the owner. During the renovation project, ample time was spent visiting stone yards and selecting the perfect wood stains for joinery. The finished result is a warm, inviting home that feels decadent yet comforting, with natural materials such as marble and wood used throughout.






We opted for warmer tones like yellows, sands and golds to achieve a cosy, welcoming and relaxing atmosphere, something that is much welcomed when a bedroom risks lacking the warm glow of sunshine. A large painting by Fernando Casasempere takes centre stage above the vanity area which doubles up as a desk. When considering the right piece of art which would fit with the mood of the bedroom, it was important to ensure that it was hung and lit correctly too. 







































This white stucco-fronted home in Pimlico became an 18-month labour of love during its total transformation. Despite challenging access, this 3-bed, 3-bath duplex apartment underwent a full modernisation, complete with a new heating and cooling system, home automation, and a complete reconfiguration of the space.

We curated an aesthetically attractive home that is both comfortable and stylishly designed. Golden brown hues in the wooden shelving and floorboards of the living room emphasise cosiness, while richer materials, including a swivel armchair adorned with luxurious Dedar fabric, a round marble table, and an Art Deco-inspired marble fireplace, elevate the space with notes of luxury design.

The beauty of natural materials is showcased in the stained oak joinery, seamlessly connecting the living, kitchen, and dining areas. Guillerme et Chambron dining chairs, reupholstered in plush patterned fabric, add another layer of material luxury. Thoughtful touches, such as the fluted wooden doors for the under stairs storage, create distinctive boundaries throughout the home.








Upstairs, the theme of stylish comfort continues with a Dedar Tiger Mountain fabric headboard, fluted wooden wardrobes, and side tables, further enhancing the opulent updates.

The powder room adds a touch of drama with textured wallpaper from Arte International and a striking wall-hung marble basin. The intentional clash of patterns and textures throughout brings intrigue and a subtle edge to this distinctive home.











Muted tones, rich accents, and natural materials blend seamlessly to create a fusion of loft luxury, Art Deco elegance, and industrial chic. The space is reconfigured to maximise its expansive, airy feel, with large Crittall windows flooding the interior with natural light and offering striking skyline views. The open, lateral layout flows effortlessly into a substantial private terrace, enhancing the overall sense of space.

Subtle Art Deco details and splashes of colour elevate the design, while carefully selected materials like marble, metal, and glass maintain an industrial edge. The space remains intentionally underfurnished, allowing bold architectural features – high ceilings, curved walls, and industrial proportions – to take centre stage. Each element, from period-inspired fixtures to soft furnishings, complements the overall design, resulting in understated luxury with a distinct, Manhattan-inspired aesthetic.





Thoughtfully transformed, this super prime Park Modern property overlooking Kensington Gardens saw the fourth bedroom reimagined as a separate kitchen. The new layout elegantly redefined the apartment's floor plan, allowing for a living and dining room while establishing the kitchen in its own dedicated space.

This kitchen showcases how a subtler colour scheme can uphold sophistication by incorporating a variety of textures. Natural materials in neutral tones define the space, from the pale Mundy veneer kitchen cabinets to the luxurious worktops, splashback, and island. A calming pale neutral colour adorns the walls, and the smooth natural stone tiles on the floor enhance the serene atmosphere. Although the colour scheme conveys sophisticated simplicity, ideal for urban apartments, the fluted glass cabinet above the sink creates a dynamic focal point, further highlighted by hanging fluted glass pendants from British lighting designer J Adams & Co. Stained oak grain bar stools with leather tops soften the space, while the island's base, with its hand-finished liquid metal treatment adds depth, complexity, and opulence.















Located in the heart of one of England's iconic seaside towns is this former Baptist Chapel, with spectacular panoramic views over the harbour and Kingsland Estuary.



The Domus Hosting Kitchen creates feelings of inspiration, fun, and community through a palette of muted yet richly earthy tones, making it the beating heart of this thoughtfully designed, fully functional showroom.

Vert de Moneteau Argile paint on the walls, bespoke stained joinery and porcelain slabs on the kitchen worktops, splashback, and central cooking island create a mood balancing environment. The brass kitchen stools feature intricate grooving and T-bar footrests, finished with moss-green leather tops. The luxury branched Haara pendant from London-based Cameron Design House beautifully diffuses the light through hand-drawn glass – a striking piece fitting for virtually any interior aesthetic. A custom designed banquette sofa in earthy terracotta tones creates a social and comfortable space for inspirational collaboration.










Our team carried out a complete backto-brick refurbishment and extension to transform this private residential property into an inner-city sanctuary suitable for both relaxing and entertaining.




















This three bedroom home on London's much desired Hamilton Terrace required a time sensitive back-to-brick refurbishment which our studio completed in under four months.

We provided full interior architectural services and took design inspiration from a combination of eras, particularly Art Deco influences from the 1920s, which we fused with the classic period features of the apartment.


We created more space by returning the ceilings to their original late-Edwardian proportions and converted the living area into a large, multi-purpose space where the kitchen, living and dining spaces all flow into each other. This injected a sense of modernity and created a warm, relaxed and comfortable environment. Award-winning specialists John Cullen Lighting created a bespoke lighting scheme and the bedrooms were fitted with functional, beautiful pieces of custom-made furniture and joinery.















Our vision for this 3000+ sqm property in Phuket was to create a serene, modern space with earthy colours, influenced by the surrounding natural environment. The interiors are an opulent, modern take on oriental-style architecture, with a coastal-inspired colour palette that creates an atmosphere conducive to calm.

Each room in the property was a suite featuring its own living, bathroom and wardrobe areas as well as a private terrace with ocean views. Low Oriental-style beds, inroom freestanding baths and large mirrors positioned deliberately to reflect light make the space feel all the more expansive.

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As part of our commitment to Interior Design Declares,

To do so, we have enlisted a group of sustainability consultants,
Sustaineers Consultants, to help us calculate and estimate our
footprint for our last financial year. This has covered all of our
activities both at our London base and at our project sites.
It includes materials we buy and how they are used in homes
during their lifespan. Looking ahead, we are planning how
we can reduce our emissions and tracking our progress
by regularly measuring our footprint and reporting on it yearly.
What we cannot reduce will be offset through the Gold
Standard offset projects.

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SUSTAINABILITY IN DESIGN

Sustainability in our projects can be as subtle or prominent as the client wishes, but it will always be one of our key considerations. We will source products and materials as locally as possible, prioritising those that promote a healthy indoor climate, from companies with transparent supply chains. We will keep waste to a minimum by helping clients to repurpose, sell or recycle unwanted furniture, and by ensuring construction waste is recycled where possible. Avoiding "fast furniture", our studio will inspire our clients with timeless design choices and products which are made to last.

CARBON OFFSETTING

We calculate our carbon footprint and take steps to reduce our emissions as well as offset what is unavoidable. Through our offsetting, Designed by Woulfe chooses to support a programmes which helps to improve living conditions in a sustainable way for communities who have been disproportionately affected by climate change.
